CHECKLISTS

First-Year Students

- Submit a completed application for admission.
- Have your official high school transcript, showing coursework and grades, or GED scores mailed to the Admissions Office at:

Transfer Students

- Complete all steps listed under First-Year Students.
- Have an official, sealed transcript from each college and university attended mailed directly to the Registrar.

Note: Transfer credits only accepted from regionally accredited institutions.

Home-Schooled Students

- Complete all steps listed under First-Year Students.
- Send a list of courses and grades along with any documentation from the state or national home schooling accreditation agency.

CCP Students (current 7th-12th graders)

- Inform your high school guidance counselor of your intent to participate in the program during the upcoming school year by April 1st.
- Have your guidance counselor submit your preliminary high school transcript.
- Complete all steps listed under First-Year Students, excluding Financial Aid.
