The Chatfield Achievement Grant is available to all Cincinnati Public graduates who meet the eligibility requirements. **The goal of the grant to provide a partnership with our Cincinnati Public School community and invest in students who dream of college, but unable to afford tuition.**

ELIGIBILITY

- Must be a high school graduate of Cincinnati Public Schools, 2018-present, and attended for at least one full academic year with CPS prior to graduation
- Final GPA of 2.20 or higher
- First-time enrolling as a traditional college student (no transfers or previously enrolled)
- Must apply for financial aid and qualify for the Federal Pell Grant
- Enroll full-time for fall and spring semesters (part-time not eligible)
- Must be admitted into a program of study by Chatfield College

SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

- After the application of the Federal Pell Grant and state aid, Chatfield covers the cost of tuition, fees for fall and spring semesters.
- Students will be given a book allowance.
- Students must be enrolled full-time (min. 12 credit hours).
- Grant will be affected by other Chatfield College scholarships or grants that are included in the institutional aid.
- Scholarships awarded by other outside entities or institutions will not affect the Chatfield Merit Scholarship.
- Renewable up to two years or four semesters.
- Must maintain Pell Grant eligibility each year.
- Students must maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) while continuously enrolled full-time for the Fall and Spring semesters.
